Prairie Crossing Fine Arts Festival Set for September 17 and 18

The [Lake County Art League \(LCAL\)](#) will hold its annual [Prairie Crossing Fine Arts Festival](#) on [Saturday and Sunday, September 17 and 18](#), from [10 a.m. to 5 p.m.](#) on the grounds of [The Shops at Station Square](#), 970 Harris Road off Route 137 approximately one mile west of Route 45, across from the [Metra Station in Grayslake](#).
